Beginning, June 20, 2021, we will move forward with a new 3 phase plan regarding POST COVID-19 precautions and structure for our ministries.

PHASE 1 - RETHINK (June 20 thru July 31)

-Masks: Anyone who has been fully vaccinated is welcome with or without wearing a mask. The CDC recommends that anyone who is unvaccinated still wear a mask for their safety and the safety of others while indoors. We support this recommendation.

-Social Distancing: Social Distancing will remain every other pew throughout Phase 1. We are still asking all attendees to social distance and refrain from handshakes and hugs. For now, we want to ensure that we do not have a potential "spread" of COVID-19 since there have been active exposures in families but not directly in the church.

-Masks-Only Section: Some of our attendees have health conditions that prevent them from getting vaccinated. Additionally, young children are unable to be vaccinated. In order to protect our most vulnerable attendees, we are reserving a section of seats where adults must wear masks for entirety of the class or service. You may also choose to wear a mask anywhere you are seated, but the masks-only section is reserved for full-time mask-wearing only.

-Sickness: If you are sick, vaccinated or not, we invite you to join us online. Please help us ensure that our church is a safe place for everyone.

-Concerning Vaccinations: As a way to safeguard ourselves against judgment and division, we request that attenders do not ask one another if they have or have not received the vaccine, or why or why not someone continues to wear a mask.

During PHASE 1 We will begin to secure leaders/teachers for our small groups: Adults, Youth and Children. We will reexamine rooms for the best set-up, supplies and needs. We will make recommendations for meeting times and schedules for PHASE 3.

We are excited for things to start getting back to "normal", or at least some form of it! Let's do our best to love each other well, and above all keep our eyes on Christ!

PHASE 2 - REFRESH (August 1 thru September 11)

The Challenge for Phase 2 is for personal refreshing of our Mind, Spirit and Soul, with an emphasis on Prayer. Make a conscious effort to connect with people outside of worship or small group, not currently attending worship or small group.

Be intentional in our outreach, contact and connection with people who have not been attending regularly. Each one; reach one, concept.
