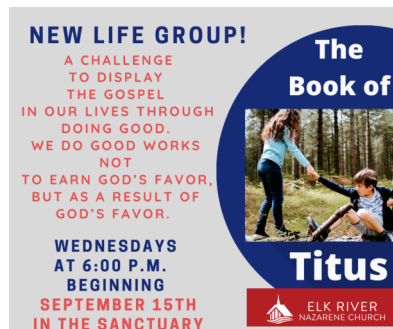


Please sign up in the foyer for **Ladies Night Out** on September 7th, at 6:30 p.m.
