

The 6th Annual Ladies Day will be held at the Nazarene Campground in Summersville, on Saturday, September 11, 2021.


Registration begins at 9:30 a.m. and is \$25.




Please sign up in the foyer for Ladies Night Out on September 7th, at 6:30 p.m. We will meet at Plaza Maya in Kanawha City.
