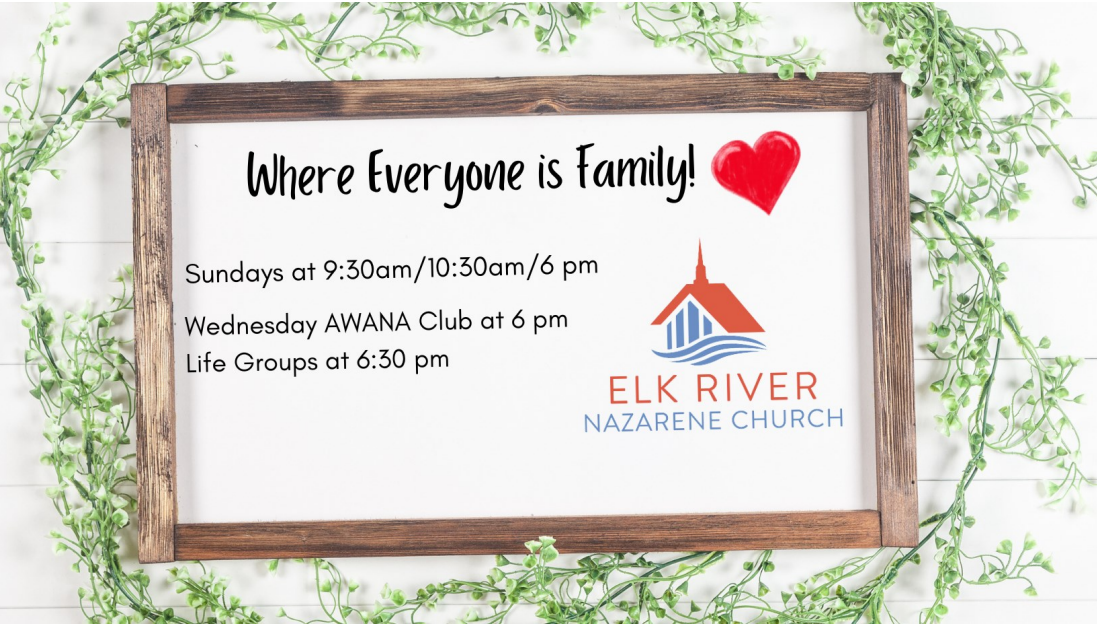

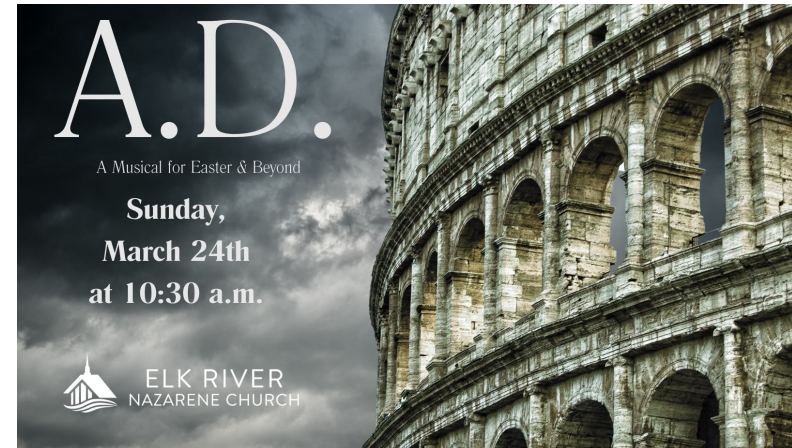
April Showers
