



Please register at <u>GriefShare.org</u> if you are interested. Your GriefShare experience includes three key elements that work together to help you recover from the deep hurt of the loss of a loved one. Your sessions will include a video, a group discussion, and your personal workbook. The first step to joining the June session is to register online before May 25, 2025. You will receive a confirmation within 72 hours and then you go back to your registration and order and pay for your workbook. If you do not receive confirmation, you need to re-register.
