

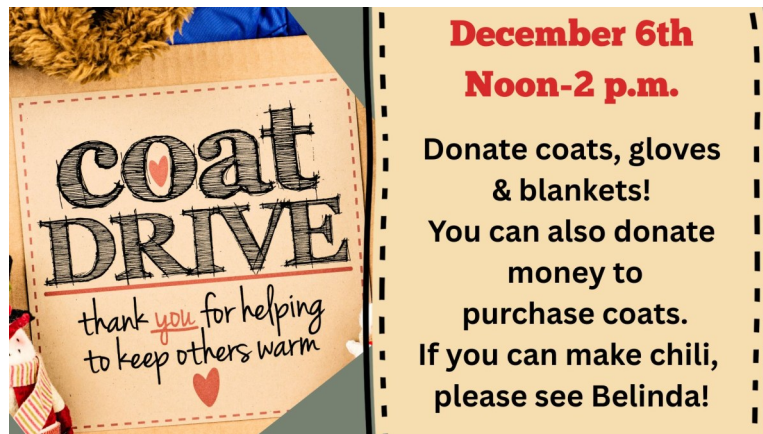
Opportunities to Help Others

Our Children's Church Christmas Program will be on Sunday, December 7th, at 10:30 a.m.

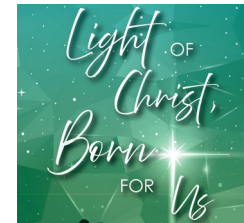

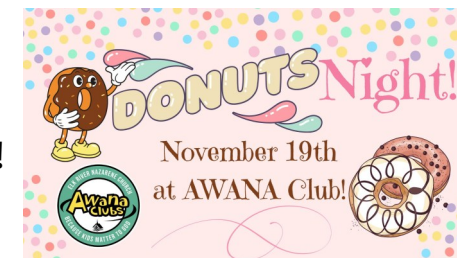
